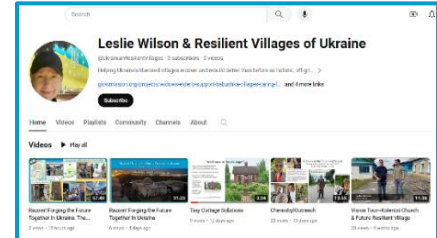
Please let me share with you God's ministry in Ukraine. So far 17 months, and likely the rest of my days, by God's sovereign hand. It's been incredible to witness God at work through our small Ukrainian (+ 1 American) team. So few of God's people minister to these impoverished, partially-deserted villages of the Chernobyl region. They suffered greatly under occupation in 2022, russians inflicting indescribable acts of terror on these mostly elderly villagers.

Ours is the first non-Orthodox church in the region. Gradually, more villagers come as they see our love and care for them:

- Driving 12-hour home-outreaches regularly to 50+ elderly & homebound in 15+ villages, bringing food, staples, help, and the power of prayer
- Expanding partnership with 60+ school-age children following our summer Bible camp
- Growing ministry to off-duty soldiers who are rotated here from the brutal front lines
- Racing to get several of our elderly babushkas into safe housing on our church property



Only God could unite our two missions, Maksim Dyomkin's team and my Resilient Village project, to meet desperate spiritual and physical needs in Ukraine at war. I'll be allowed back in November 24th. **NEW!** ICRC* asked me to help bring a landmine awareness training to our villages and possible partnering with Ukrainian Ministry of Reintegration. A new level! Perhaps the long-awaited work visa!

Winter is coming. Missile strikes are still destroying power, heat, and water supplies. Our team is working hard to winterize the church and "summer house" to live in. **Priority: heat** (wood stove \$700, firewood \$450). A total of **\$3000 to winterize the church** (see attached). Hopefully, in early December, the church will be winterized enough for me to "camp out" as the church's first permanent presence there. We are still assessing the best way to help babushka housing needs.

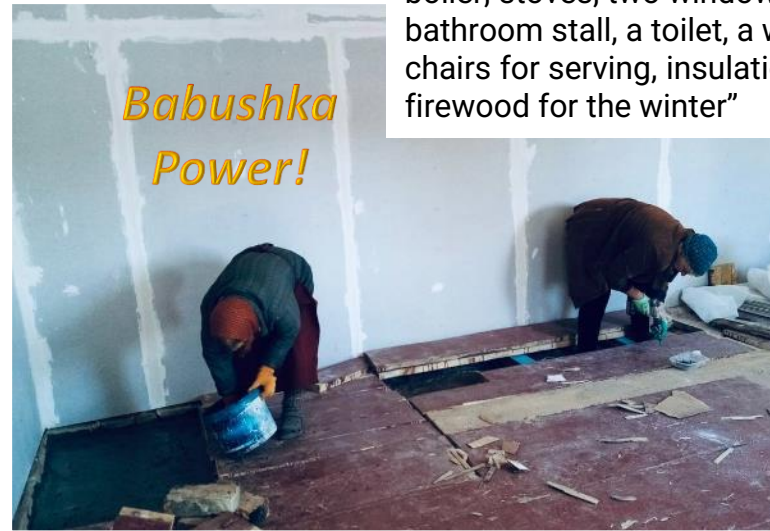
